



Oncorhynchus masou formosanus, commonly known as the **Formosan landlocked salmon**, is a rare and endangered subspecies of the masu salmon. It has a silver body marked with dark spots and a pink stripe along its side. The fish is named after cherry blossoms (“櫻花”) due to its distinctive coloration.
